Cotton, cotton buds Crayons, solvent-free Cuddly toys Disks Document file made from plastic Dolls Doormats Ends of candles Erasers Extractor hood filters Felt-tip pens, dried out Film / film material Fireproof glass Flashlight, without batteries Fountain pens, empty Furs Garden hoses Glasses defective Inline skates Leather bags, belts Lenses Lightbulbs Lighters, empty Mirrors Napkins, soiled Nappies Nylon tights Packaging, heavily soiled Paper, heavily soiled or coloured through Paper towels, paper handkerchiefs, soiled Parchment paper Photographs Plasters Porcelain Rags Razor blades Rollerskates Rubber hot water bottles Rubber materials Sanitary towels Scraps of linoleum Shoes, unusable Skateboards Slides Small wooden objects Soot, packaged Spark plugs Sweepings Synthetic leather Syringes, packaged to protect against injury Tampons Thermal paper Thermos flasks Vacuum cleaner bags Wallpaper scraps Wound dressing material Wrapping paper, coated 	<p>Waste paper, like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Advertisements Baker's bags, with and without windows Books Brochures Cardboard Cartons Catalogues Document folders made from cardboard Egg cartons Envelopes, with and without windows Journals Leaflets Magazines Newspapers Notebooks Packaging made from paper, cardboard, cartons Paper packaging Paper towels, when only damp Paper, loose Posters Wrapping paper, uncoated Writing paper <p>Waste paper can also be disposed of through the waste paper collections.</p> <p>Tip for more space in the bin: Fold up or tear up cartons to save space.</p> <p>Avoid unnecessary paper waste by placing a „No adverts“ sticker on your letterbox.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Banana skin Biodegradable refuse bags made from paper Bones Bread Cheese scraps Coffee grounds Cut flowers Diseased house plants Egg shells Expired foods, without packaging Fish and meat scraps Food scraps (no soups or sauces) Fruit scraps Hair Jute Lemon peel Non-woody green waste in small quantities Nut shells Orange peel Potted plants Sausage scraps Seeds Teabags Vegetable peelings <p>Tip: Wrap the biodegradable waste in newspaper or put it in paper bags.</p> <p>Do not use bags made of plastic or compostable bioplastics.</p> <p>Biodegradable waste which does not come from households must be disposed of as commercial waste.</p> <p>If no organic waste garbage can available: Compost at home.</p>	<p>Plastics, like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bottles, canisters Buckets, emptied CDs Disposable tableware Foil, plastic bags Mixing bowls Styropor (small parts in transparent bags) <p>Metals, like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Baking moulds Brass bowls Crown caps Cutlery Frying pans, saucepans Metal sheets Tins, emptied Tool parts <p>Aluminium, like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chocolate wrappers Household foil Tubes, free from hazardous materials, emptied Yoghurt pot lids <p>Composite packaging, like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blister packaging Juice cartons, emptied Milk cartons, emptied Vacuum packaging <p>Sales packaging, emptied with a spoon, made from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wood, plastic, metal
