

Waste paper can also be disposed of through the waste paper collections.

Tip for more space in the bin: Fold up or tear up cartons to safe space.

 - or sauces) Fruit scraps

 - Non-woody green waste in small quantities
 - Nut shells
 - Orange peel
 - Potted plants
 - Sausage scraps
 - Teabags
 - Vegetable peelings

Wrap the biodegradable waste in newspaper or put it in paper bags.

Do not use bags made of plastic or compostable bioplastics.

Biodegadable waste which does not come from households must be disposed of as commercial waste.

If no organic waste garbage can available: Compost at

Recyclable materials

Plastics, like:

- Bottles, canisters
- Buckets, emptied
- CDs
- Disposable tableware
- Foil, plastic bags
- Mixing bowls
- Styropor (small parts in transparent bags)

Metals, like:

- Baking moulds
- Brass bowls
- Crown caps
- Cutlery Frying pans, saucepans
- Metal sheets
- Tins, emptied Tool parts

Aluminium, like:

- Chocolate wrappers
- Household foil
- Tubes, free from hazardous materials, emptied
- Yoghurt pot lids

Composite packaging, like:

- Blister packaging
- Juice cartons, emptied Milk cartons, emptied Vacuum packaging

Sales packaging, emptied

with a spoon, made from: Wood, plastic, metal


